This meeting is MANDATORY to all graduates. Please plan accordingly.



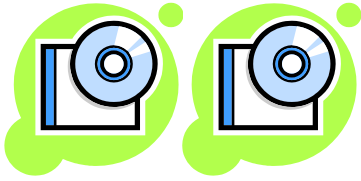
Senior **G**rad **B**ags will be provided for all graduates at the meeting on June 4th. Each grad bag will have:

Graduation **T**ickets – Each graduate will receive 2 **Vehicle** passes. **Admission will be by ticket only. There is a limit of 2 vehicles per graduate.** Space on the field must have a graduate in the vehicle. The 2nd ticket will be for the track around the field and that space is VERY limited.

Parking will begin at 11:00 a.m. graduates are to be at the school and parked on the football field by 12:45 p.m.

Immunization Records Seniors will receive their original immunization and health records in their **Grade Bag** on June 4th. Anyone who has had a shot or a booster in recent years should get this information to Mrs. Buker in the Nurse's Office by email at abuker@aos94.org as soon as possible. This is your **permanent** health card and it is the **ONLY** record of this type. This shows the results of various testings, dates of shots, etc. This information is often needed by employers or colleges. It is strongly suggested that this information be kept by you in a **safe** place!

IMPORTANT REMINDER FROM THE PRINCIPAL:

ALL Seniors are reminded that graduation is a very important time in your life. Taking part in the graduation is a privilege. You are reminded that proper attire should be worn during graduation. Car decorations on the field are encouraged, but must be appropriate. If anything is deemed inappropriate, you will **not** be allowed to park on the field or take part in the ceremony.

Under your caps and gowns you are encouraged to follow the appropriate guidelines for attire –



Women: White dresses and dress shoes (heels are discouraged as the ground is uneven and may be soft).



Men: Dress shirts and slacks, ties, socks and dress shoes.
